

CityReach Summer Day Camps

July 4th- September 2nd, 2011 · Ages: Kindergarten- Grade 7

Registration: Please fill out the Summer Registration Form indicating the weeks that you would like to have your child attend. Daily drop-in spaces will be available depending on the enrollment for that given day. If you need to cancel, or your child will not be attending that day, please let us know as soon as possible.

Registration Fee: There is a non-refundable fee of \$25.00. This includes the cost of a CityReach Summer T-shirt and holds your child's space for the weeks you have registered for.

Fees: The fee for one week is \$145.00 and \$130.00 for each additional child (except weeks 3 and 5- see the last page). The fee for daily drop-in rates varies depending on the day (for an 'in' day, the rate is \$30.00). A 10% discount will be given to families registering for 7 weeks or more. No refunds will be given if your child does not attend the week which you have paid for. ***Fee are due at the beginning of each week; you're child will not be allowed to stay on Monday morning unless fees have been paid.*** The fees include a nutritious morning and afternoon snack, the costs of all outings, and all transportation.

Arrival and Departure: We will be open Monday-Friday from 7:30AM- 6:00PM and closed Statutory holidays. It is your responsibility to have your child picked up by 6:00PM. If you have an emergency, please have an alternate individual pick up your child. Parents who arrive at the centre later than 6:00PM. will be charged \$10.00 for the first fifteen minutes and \$15.00 for every 15 minutes after. A warning will be given for the first offence. After the second offence, parents will be charged accordingly.

Please have your child here by 10:00AM each day. There may be days where we need to leave earlier than 10:00AM for an outing. You will find this information on the "Week at a Glance" information notice. This will give you the particular information for that week (themes, outing info, what to bring, departure/ arrival times). Please pick one of these up each week. ***We are unable to wait for late children.***

Clothing: Your registration fee covers the cost of a summer t-shirt. These should be brought EVERY DAY and are always worn on outings to help staff keep everyone together. If one of these t-shirts is lost or damaged, you will be required to purchase a new one.

HATS must be worn and brought every day. On days when we are outside, if your child does not have a hat, he/she will be required to stay in the shaded area only. We recommend purchasing a hat to leave here so that your child will never be without one.

SUNSCREEN must be worn every day as well. Please send a bottle with your child.

Please also send a swimsuit, towel, an water bottle with your child daily. We often make trips to the park and will have water games or wading pools to play in.

Weather: We have planned many outdoor activities that are contingent upon good weather. If the weather is less than optimal, we may have to substitute or temporarily move an outing to a different day or week.
